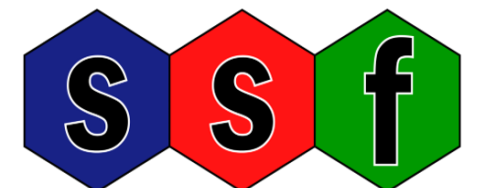

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The SSF Project is an initiative of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) to boost product innovation of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs).

The project provides machinery, equipment and tools to eligible cooperators under a shared system to improve the competitiveness of MSMEs.

The cooperators (e.g., cooperatives, people's organization, industry associations, local government units, state universities/colleges) manage the SSFs for common use of MSME beneficiaries engaged in the identified industry clusters.

OBJECTIVES

- Enable MSMEs to increase their productivity;
- Improve MSME's competitiveness by giving them access to better technologies and more sophisticated equipment;
- Accelerate MSME graduation to the next level where they could tap a better and wider market share and be integrated in the global supply chain;
- Address the gap and bottlenecks in the value chain of priority industry clusters;
- Promote convergence of resources among stakeholders whenever possible.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Proposed projects must address the processing and manufacturing gaps or bottlenecks of the priority industry cluster
- Proposed projects are expected to increase MSME productivity in terms of: a) product improvement, quality enhancement, and marketability; b) price competitiveness; and, c) conformity to standards.
- Proposed projects will support microenterprises within the priority industry clusters.
- Proposed projects that will improve the products of the One-Town One-Product (OTOP) shall likewise be considered.

ELIGIBLE COOPERATORS/ BENEFICIARIES:

The following eligible cooperators/ beneficiaries may submit proposal for a shared service facility:

1. Government entities

- Local Government Units
- State Universities & Colleges
- Technical or Vocational schools

2. Private Entities

- Non-Government Organizations
- People's Organizations
- Cooperatives
